**TEMPORARY ORDER IN RESPONSE TO THE COVID-19 (CORONAVIRUS)
PUBLIC HEALTH CRISIS**

Whereas, Dr. Amy Acton, Director of the Ohio Department of Health on March 14, 2020 issued a Director's Order closing all K-12 schools in the State of Ohio and on March 20, 2020 issued a Director's Stay at Home Order, the Court Orders, effective immediately that:

1. All parties subject to a parenting time (visitation) Order through this Court shall continue to exchange their child(ren) as required by the existing Orders.
2. Pursuant to Section 14(e) of Director Acton's Stay at Home Order, Drop off and pick up for parenting time shall be considered "Essential Travel."
3. For all parenting time, the parties shall exchange all information and materials necessary to continue home schooling as directed by the child's respective school district.
4. With respect to parenting time issues and the state-ordered school closures, parents who have shared parenting plans for custody orders shall continue to follow those orders.
5. Parties shall adhere to all holiday and spring break schedules as designated by their schools at the beginning of the school year regardless of recent changes.


